Change of clothes

Can all parents please ensure that their child has a spare set of clothes either in their tray or on their peg. Loose Parts

'Loose parts' theory is about remembering that the best play comes from things that allow children to play in many different ways and on many different levels. Environments that include 'loose parts' are infinitely more stimulating and engaging than static ones. The play environment needs to promote and support imaginative play through the provision of 'loose parts' in a way that doesn't direct play and play opportunities but allows children to develop their own ideas and explore their world.

We are looking to expand our collection of loose parts around the nursery indoors and outdoors. We have a list of items which you may have and probably have put in the bin.

Can we ask that if you have any items that you hand them in to the nursery.

Nature loose parts

- Acorns
- Feathers
- Leaves
- Pinecones, pebbles
- Sand, shell, sticks, stones
- Tree stumps, twigs

Creative and Messy Play

- Beads, bottle tops
- Cardboard boxes, cotton wool, corks
- Glass stones, glue, googly eyes, glitter, greeting cards
- Paint and brushes, pipe cleaners, pom poms
- Sponges

- Wrapping paper
- Yoghurt pots

Metal

- Baking trays, bottle tops
- CDs, cooking utensils
- Muffin tins
- Spoons

Household Items

- Basin, basket, blankets, buckets

- Building blocks
