Can we please ask all parent to provide their child with indoor and outdoor shoes for the nursery. This is for the benefit of cleanliness throughout the nursery.



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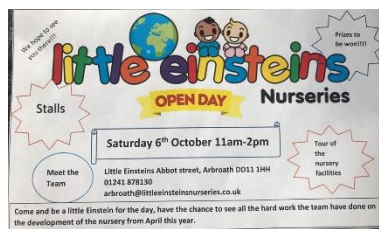
Stay and play sessions
